Solar inverters with integrated DC isolators – Certification extension period

Tasmania is a member jurisdiction of the Electrical Regulatory Authorities Council (ERAC) and the Standing Committee of Officials (SCO) of the Electrical Equipment Safety System (EESS).

ERAC and the SCO of the EESS have released a statement announcing that solar inverters incorporating DC isolators do not require certification to AS/NZS 4777.2:2020 to be sold or installed in member jurisdictions across Australia until **30 June 2022**.

This extension of time acknowledges the challenges manufacturers and suppliers are having with obtaining the relevant certification.
